
He pursued his training in France and the USA. He founded neurology and spinal interventional center in south Alabama that grew to become the leading center in the area, which served the entire southeast states for over 21 years until he retired from practice in 2017.

Dr. Tarabein is now active mentoring physicians with lectures and workshops on Spinal Interventions, besides writing, editing, and speaking at the national and international arenas.

Professional Experience:

- 1) 1977:** Concluded premedical education at "Ibn Khaldun School", graduated with Outstanding Honors, in the top 10 in Syria (population 28 million).
- 2) 1977-1983:** Attended medical education at the University of Damascus School of Medicine, accelerated six years M.D. program, Graduated with honors and awards.

- 3) **1983-1985:** Served in the armed forces as an officer physician, headed a medical military trauma center in Lebanon amid its gruesome civil war, where he developed his passion for neurosciences. He was discharged from the military with high honors and a full scholarship to pursue neurosurgery training in France.
- 4) **1985-1990:** Pursued neurosurgery training at the *Universite' Du Dijon*. He was mentored by professor *Boissel*, the most renowned neurosurgeon in Europe, where he developed his unique skills in spinal interventions and pain management.
- 4) **1990-1992:** Professor and researcher at the University of Wisconsin Madison. He worked there on NIH funded study in neuroscience in sleep apnea.
- 5) **1992-1993:** Attended internship training at Saint Louis University hospitals and clinics.
- 6) **1993-1994:** neurology residency training at Saint Louis University hospitals in St Louis, Mo.
- 7) **1994-1996:** concluded Neurology residency training program at the University of South Alabama in Mobile, AL.
- 8) **1996-2017:** Founded Eastern Shore Neurology & Pain Center in South Alabama. He remained its owner, CEO, and president till he retired in 2017.



- 9) **2017-present:** Founded Cell Therapy International (CTI, Inc.), aiming at a natural cure for neurological diseases.

Dr. Tarabein uses several tests to properly diagnose his patients. Many of these tests can be performed in his office. These tests include: EMG/NCV, Doppler ultrasound and neurovascular studies, carotid Doppler/ultrasound, EEG, and EMG needle guided injections.
Proper testing is essential for correct diagnosis since MRI technology, although effective, provides a limited view. Additionally, other tests may be necessary to better pinpoint the cause of the pain, discomfort or other underecognized symptoms.
Understanding that the patient's knowledge of their body is important, Dr. Tarabein is a spontaneous listener and is more
