



Dr. Taraben uses several tests to properly diagnose his patients. Most of these tests can be performed in his office. These tests include: DRUGS/TXN, Digital ultrasound and non-invasive methods, central Doppler ultrasound, EEG, and EMG, and digital myography.



Dr. Taraben takes a conservative approach in treating his illness, with a specific focus on controlling the patient's pain and other related symptoms (if at all possible), using low dose drug treatments first, strictly avoiding surgery altogether. Dr. Taraben provides a variety of pain management options for his patients. For instance, he would not give a controlled substance if a patient is considered a low risk.
